Classes will be conducted at **Herbert Hoover Boys & Girls Club** and the **Teen Center of Excellence** campuses.

In collaboration with the Contemporary Art Museum St. Louis, the Best Buy Teen Tech Center and Teen Center of Excellence of the Boys and Girls Clubs of Greater St. Louis

In this five-week workshop, students will work with local artist Kevin McCoy to research local neighborhoods impacted by the construction of the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) campus in north St. Louis, and will design banners to commemorate their cultural, historical, and economic contributions. These completed banners will be displayed along a major, highly visible street of a local neighborhood near the NGA West site.

Students will learn the basics of graphic design and how to navigate some basic Adobe design programs.
